COMMUNITY WORKSHOP #4 Envisioning the Future in the Field

The community input received over the course of the three public workshops that have been held for the Santa Fe Depot Specific Plan Update highlight the complexity of planning for the future of a treasured portion of the City that is in a state of transition. The purpose of this walking workshop is to consider the land use options presented at Workshop #3 in relation to actual field conditions.

The workshop will consist of block-by-block interactive observations and discussion about the range of issues that will be addressed in the Specific Plan Update including:

- Historic Character and Resources
- Properties in Transition
- Types and Relationships of Uses
- Building Height
- Train and Bus Activity
- Pedestrian Conditions and Linkage Opportunities
- Parking
- Adaptive Reuse and Opportunity Sites

The input received at the workshop will be used to further refine a preferred land use alternative and establish a vision for the area that will be used as the basis for the policies, development and design standards, and infrastructure improvements that will be contained in the updated Specific Plan.

The workshop will involve extensive walking, so please wear comfortable shoes!

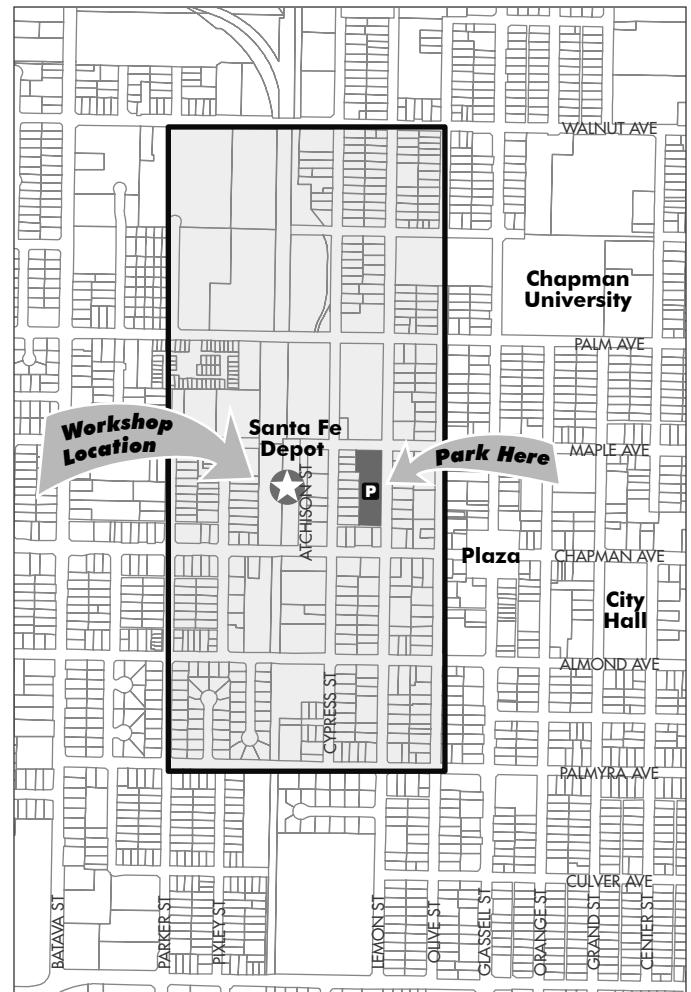
